



FEEE Funded places at Wood St Nursery

Wood St Nursery is a 'Year Round Provider', a childcare provider who is open for more than 38 weeks of the year. We are open for 48 weeks of the year.

We offer several scenarios for taking up a funded place at Wood St Nursery

Scenario 1 – for working families' entitlement – for families who want to take up their funded early education and childcare as part of a package of care and education.

We offer 3, 4 or 5 day places. For further information please go to 'Fees' on our website, and to register for a place, please go to 'Registration' on our website.

Please note Wood St Nursery is oversubscribed, all places are subject to availability and you may need to join a waiting pool.

Scenario 2 – for working families' entitlement - for families who want to access their funded hours only.

Under the Government scheme parents/carers are entitled to an annual free early education and childcare entitlement of **23.75hrs* per week over 48 weeks per annum** at Wood St Nursery, which equates to 1140hrs per year equivalent to 30hrs per week over 38 weeks).

The setting operates **Monday-Friday 8am-5pm**, offering sessions of **9** hours of childcare per day on a year-round basis.

The setting offers places to children from 10 months old until the child reaches statutory school age.

Working parents/carers who want to take up only free early education and childcare hours can do this, and are able to take this up as 18 hours per week. **As with all part time places at Wood St Nursery one of these days must include a Monday or a Friday and 1 day of their choice** (at 9 hrs per day between 8am and 5pm, subject to availability); alternative days will be offered where preferred days are not available (subject to availability).

There is an additional charge for food, consumables, and extra activities for families accessing funded hours. The additional charge is broken down for your information. These charges are not mandatory; therefore you can opt out of what is provided if you do not wish to pay the additional charge.

Entitlement to a free place does not offer a guarantee of a place at any one provider. Parents/carers are therefore able to take up the remaining balance of their free early education entitlement (5.75 hours per week) with an alternative provider should they choose, to ensure that they are able to take up their full free early education and childcare entitlement hours across two providers.

Parents/carers do not have to take up additional childcare hours in addition to the 18 hours of free early education and childcare hours offered per week, but can request these should they want to.

Where parents/carers choose to purchase childcare hours which are in addition to/outside of their free early education and childcare hours, these will be charged as set out below:

Scenario 3 - for deprivation funding entitlement.
